▶ **Leveraged the EAB Navigate tool to identify and engage students who may show early signs of low course performance.**

▶ **Employed several alert reasons including Keep Up the Good Work.**


▶ **Partnered with Academic Dean to communicate with faculty.**

▶ **Cases were automatically assigned to staff advisors, Dean and CARE team.**


Fall 2021 Early Alerts- Outcomes
