



# A Very Simple Example of Predictive Modeling

#### **Drawing Face Cards**

Suppose that 4 out of 5 cards you draw from deck A are face cards.

Now suppose that 1 out of 5 cards you draw from deck B are face cards.

The drawn cards are put back in their respective decks. Supposing you want to draw a face card,


which deck do you think is more likely to give you a face card?





## Removing the Guesswork via Predictive Models

#### **Individual Outcome Likelihood**



Predictive modeling is essentially the process of...

- 1 Testing whether those relationships are sufficiently systematic
- Creating the best possible estimate of those relationships

#### The Three Major Steps of Using Predict



#### **Loading Data**

- Understanding key data requirements for Predict
- · Bring the data into Predict



#### **Reviewing / Verifying that Data**

- Ensuring key characteristics are present
- Discovering anything out of the ordinary prior to modeling

#### **Building / Verifying the Model**

- Constructing the initial model equation
- Reviewing key relationships, validating through discussion and visualization
